

CHECKLIST

to help you put more Fun in Your Float

- **CHILDREN MUST BE AT LEAST EIGHT (8) YEARS or OLDER AND 4 FEET TALL for TUBE RENTAL & SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE at S.R.T.R.**
- If a child does not meet **BOTH** of these requirements, SRTR does not rent tubes or provide transportation to **ANYONE** in the group. **NO EXCEPTIONS ARE PERMITTED TO THIS POLICY!**
- **LIFE VESTS** are recommended for **Children, ALL NON-SWIMMERS, inexperienced swimmers and ANY swimmer who questions whether He/She needs a life vest!**
- **ALCOHOL, DRUGS, and the Salt River DO NOT MIX!** Play it safe...Don't Do It! Have a great time responsibly and appoint a designated driver before your tubing adventure.
- **GLASS CONTAINERS are NOT ALLOWED** at Salt River Tubing or the Lower Salt River Recreational Area.
- Ice chests/coolers will be checked for glass containers. It is against the law to use glass containers at the Salt River and glass containers will be confiscated!
- **DRINK PLENTY OF WATER** while tubing. Drink at least 1-2 bottles of water per hour while floating to help prevent dehydration.
- **TENNIS SHOES** or other protective footwear are needed to protect against cuts, scrapes, and bruises while walking to/from the Salt River's entry and exit points. Shoes will help protect your feet from the River's rocky bottom.
- **SUNBLOCK** lotion should be applied **BEFORE** and **DURING** your floating trip. A minimum 30 SPF is recommended.
- **WEAR a CAP, HAT or VISOR** while tubing. It will help shield your face and head from the rays of the sun.
- **TYING the TUBES** together is **NOT** recommended.
- **STYROFOAM COOLERS** are **NOT** recommended for tubing on the Salt River.
- **LOCK YOUR VEHICLE.** Do not leave valuables in your vehicle.
- **DRIVE ONLY** on paved highways or on posted Forest Service roads.
- **DO NOT LITTER!** "Stash it and Bag it" in litter bags while tubing. Dump all trash in designated receptacles at Bus Stops. Join Salt River Tubing in being a

"Salt River Hero = Litter Zero!"

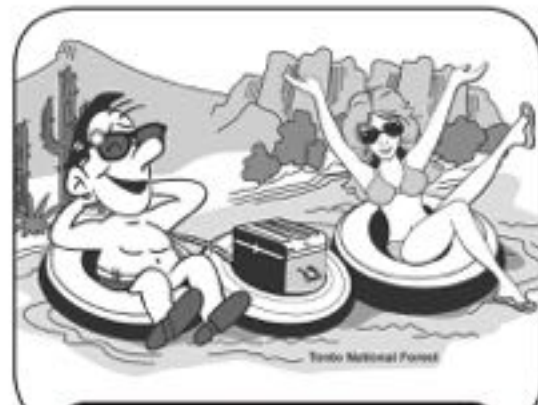

Just a short drive from Phoenix, the Salt River is a recreational paradise that offers "chills and thrills" while floating on the cool and refreshing mountain-stream waters. Enjoy a "floating picnic" and experience the natural wonders of the Salt River... wild horses, blue herons, and majestic mountains.

We offer a variety of tubes including rental tubes for ice chests. You may choose 2, 3, and 5-hour trips that include float time and bus ride, weather and water flow permitting. Six-hour trips are available on weekends only, weather and water flow permitting. Tube rentals and shuttle service are available.

7 days a week, starting at 9 a.m.

Our tubing headquarters provides clean restrooms, free customer parking, and sells cold drinks, snacks, sunscreen and life vests.

Salt River Tubing & Recreation is located in northeast Mesa, 7 miles north of Hwy. 202 E on Power Road.

We strongly recommend that you wear tennis shoes, water shoes, or other protective footwear to protect your feet from the river's rocky bottom and while walking to and from your entry/exit points of the river.

Please help keep the Salt River, desert, and Tonto National Forest clean and beautiful by using litter bags and placing trash in designated receptacles at bus stops and river exit points.

Children must be Eight (8) years or older and 4 feet tall for tubing and shuttle bus.
