Children must be at least eight years or older and four feet tall for tube rental and shuttle bus service. Glass containers are prohibited by law in the Lower Salt River Recreational Area and will be confiscated. Ice chests and coolers will be inspected for glass containers

before boarding shuttle buses. Have a great time on the Lower Salt River by responsibly appointing a designated driver before you begin your tubing adventure. Salt River Tubing operates under permit of the U.S.D.A. Forest Service in Tonto National Forest.
