Chill out and shoot the rocking Salt River rapids on a tube while beating the heat and enjoying fun in the sun. Salt River Tubing is open Friday, Saturday and Sundays in September, 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., until October 1st!

Why did thousands of tubers flock to the Lower Salt River each week during the summer? Simply, the cool and refreshing mountain-stream waters are an inviting refuge from the scorching Valley temperatures and it's an inexpensive getaway close to the Phoenix metropolitan area in beautiful Tonto National Forest! Enjoy a fun-filled, floating beach blast adventure for just \$17 for all day tubing, shuttle bus service and free parking at SRTR! Henri Breault, President/C.E.O. of Salt River Tubing, says "September is the perfect month to float on the Lower Salt River. Catch a glimpse of the wild horses crossing mid-stream, blue herons gliding across the water and the majestic mountains of the 'mini Grand Canyon' of Tonto National Forest as you float by. The Salt River offers 'chills and thrills' while tubing and creates memorable, enjoyable experiences in the great outdoors". Breault notes that non-swimmers, inexperienced swimmers and children should wear a life vest while tubing. Tubers should plan their floating picnics to include plenty of water, sun block, protective footwear, and beverages in cans or plastic containers. Glass containers are NOT permitted in the Lower Salt River Recreational Area and ice chests/coolers will be inspected before boarding shuttle buses. Breault also encourages tubers to have a great time while floating and to responsibly appoint a designated driver *BEFORE* your tubing adventure. Drugs, alcohol and the Salt River do not mix –Just don't do it!

Salt River Tubing accepts cash and credit cards (MasterCard, Visa, American Express and Discover). One valid driver's license is required for credit card identification and as a tube rental security deposit for every 5 tubes rented. Children must be at least eight years or older and four feet tall for tubing and shuttle bus service.** Salt River Tubing operates under permit of the USDA Forest Service and is located in Tonto National Forest, Mesa, Arizona.
